

Information Required for Importation of Motor Vehicles



All motor vehicles entering into New Zealand must be cleared with the Customs service, Quarantine service (MAF Biosecurity), and New Zealand Transport Agency (NZTA).

Please provide the following documentation for the Customs Clearance of your Motor Vehicle

- Completed Customs & Quarantine Declaration (*Unaccompanied Personal Baggage Declaration*)
- Copy of your passport
- Copy of relevant *visas/permits (*for immigrants*)
- Copy of registration/ownership/deregistration certificate
- Copy of purchase receipt/invoice
- Proof of 12 months continuous ownership such as insurance certificate or vehicle license document, if applying for concessionary entry relating to GST

*Visas/permits mean any of the following:

- A New Zealand Passport
- An Australian Passport
- A current New Zealand Residence visa or permit or a current New Zealand returning residents visa or permit
- A current permanent residence visa (including a resident return visa) issued by the Government of the Commonwealth of Australia
- A current New Zealand work visa or a work permit that was issued for a minimum of twelve months
- A current New Zealand work visa or work permit issued under the Work to Residency (Skilled Migrant Category) policy or the Long term Business Visa/Permit category

Please note for Registration and Compliance (post Customs Clearance) you will need to provide to the Compliance Centre: Original copies of registration/ownership/deregistration certificate
